Currently, NCDFI eMarket is one of a kind technology platform which is completely devoted to the Indian Dairy Sector, facilitating the bulk trade of commodities and services contracts for dairy sector organisations.

NCDFI eMarket has been successfully supporting the member cooperatives across the country in the seamless and market-oriented supply of dairy and Agri commodities, apart from the procurement of packaging materials, sugar, chemicals, scrap sales, etc. eAuctions have been carried out to resolve the logistic problems of various dairy cooperatives by arranging transport auctions for delivery of goods to various destinations. Moreover, its members have been opting for the hiring of labour and other services contracts through eAuctions at NCDFI eMarket.


